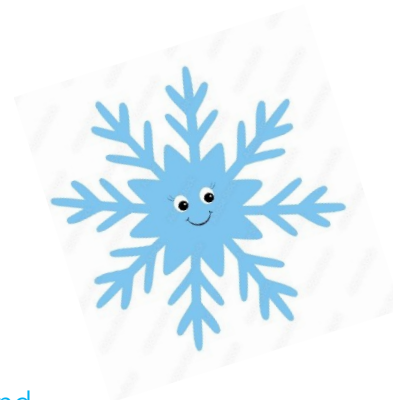


Newsletter – January 2026
