This will include bus trips into town to visit Newark beach and the civil war museum, as well as a train trip to Collingham Park. Sun- With the weather warming up again in the next few weeks it's important that we stay safe in the sun. Your child should come to nursery with pre applied suncream and a labelled sun hat. We will be spending most of our day in our air-coned rooms and staying indoors during peak heat. As usual fresh drinking water is always available for your child to help themselves, but we will be including more regular drink breaks for all children.

Food and toys- We would like to remind all parents/carers that food and drink from home is not permitted into the setting beyond the front room, this is to ensure we can protect all children from allergies. We also ask that you discourage your child from bringing their own toys into the setting, we can not be responsible if they become damaged or lost and toys from home can often cause disagreements and upsets with other children.
